## **COVID-19 Emergency Food & Childcare Assistance**



Based on the issues arising from the current COVID-19 virus, and IRS policy, the Trilogy Foundation is able to assist qualifying employees with some emergency food and childcare assistance. Please see the eligibility requirements for both programs.

## Eligibility:

- 1. Must be a full or part time employee of Trilogy Health Services, Paragon Rehabilitation, or PCA Pharmacy.
- 2. Must have dependent children in either elementary or middle school (for childcare assistance).
- 3. All school-aged children must currently participate in a free or discounted meal program (for food assistance).
- 4. Children must be enrolled at a school that has closed as a result of Coronavirus (COVID-19). Employees with children who are still in school with no closures are not eligible.
  - a. The week(s) of the school's Spring Break are not included in potential awards for either food or childcare assistance.
- 5. Employee must be scheduled to work 1<sup>st</sup> shift, and must actually work that shift.

## **Procedures & Notes:**

- Award eligibility and procedures for this program are subject to change.
- If an employee is approved for Emergency Childcare Assistance, these checks will be processed weekly with general Emergency Assistance. They will arrive at the campus on Fridays.
- Employees must apply for the Emergency Childcare Assistance program each week, and provide adequate documentation regarding the dates of school closures and Spring Breaks.
- Employees who receive approval for emergency food assistance for their children will receive direct food support (not in the form of a check).
