Guidelines for Communal Dining

POLICY

In accordance with federal guidelines for canceling communal dining during COVID-19 to ensure the health and safety of the facility's residents to meet the standards required to help each resident attain or maintain their highest level of well-being.

PURPOSE

This policy is intended to provide guidance for assisting residents that require assistance with eating. To implement social distancing to ensure appropriate residents are assisted with feeding.

PROCEDURES

- 1. All residents will be evaluated using the observation in the resident's EHR tilted "Trilogy Dining/Eating Assistance Needed".
- 2. Any resident identified as requiring assistance will be assisted by a staff member.
- 3. An order for meals in restorative dining room will be entered the resident's EHR.
- 4. A copy of the order will be given to Dining Services.
- 5. The Main dining room may be used for Restorative dining during COVID-19.
- 6. Resident's comprehensive care plan should reflect the need for assistance in feeding.
- 7. Residents evaluated as requiring assistance will be place in the Restorative dining room as follows:
 - a. One resident per table.
 - b. Tables at least six (6) feet apart.
- 8. Staff member will maintain infection control and perform frequent hand hygiene.
- 9. Resident's intake will be recorded in Care Tracker.
