FAQ for Communal Dining



- 1. Who will educate campus staff on process?
 - a. The Clinical Assessment Support nurse will educate MDSC and campus leadership
- 2. Who will complete the Observation "Trilogy Dining/Eating Assistance Needed for Resident?
 - a. The initial evaluation will be completed by the MDSC and Clinical Assessment Support team on current residents.
- 3. Who will complete the Observation "Trilogy Dining/Eating Assistance Needed" for new admissions?
 - a. Admitting nurse will complete as part of the admission data observation.
- 4. Can campus use the main dining room or restorative dining room when assisting residents?
 - a. Yes, if resident needs assistance, the staff can assist in either dining room while maintaining social distancing.
- 5. Does campus enter order for restorative dining room
 - a. Yes, in the resident EHR
- 6. Should the resident's comprehensive care plan reflect the need for assistance in feeding?a. Yes, care plan will need to be reviewed and updated
- 7. Where should intake be documented?
 - a. In Care Tracker
- 8. How far apart should tables in dining rooms be?
 - a. Six (6) feet
- 9. How many residents can be at table?
 - a. One (1)
- 10. How often does resident need re-evaluated?
 - a. When there is a change in condition.
- 11. How do I evaluate when there is a change in condition?
 - a. Use the "Trilogy Dining/Eating Assistance Needed" observation
