

Ohio Campuses Only: Hospice Visitors



Q: Are visitors allowed for a resident receiving hospice care?

A: Yes. Under the Ohio Department of Health guidelines, hospice is considered end of life care and can receive visitors as long as they pass the screening.

Q: Do visitors for a resident receiving hospice care need to be screened?

A: Yes. Current screening protocols will need to be followed prior to entry of the visitor into the campus.

Q: Who at the campus should coordinate a visit with a family of a resident receiving hospice care?

A: The ED will work with the family to coordinate visits with a resident receiving hospice care.

Q: How many visitors will be allowed for a resident receiving hospice care?

A: No more than 2 people at a time will be allowed for the visit and will be escorted to the room for their visit.

Q: Is there a time limit for visitors of a resident receiving hospice care?

A: There is no specific time limit; however, be mindful of the situation.

Q: Are young children allowed to visit a resident receiving hospice care?

A: Per the guidelines of the ODH, visitors under the age of 18 are restricted from visiting.
