# Policies & Procedures: Which policies do I need to follow, and where do I find them?

Our policies and procedures can be critical to finding quick and accurate guidance when you need it most. Below you will find some helpful information about which policies and procedures you must follow during this transition period and where to find them.

### How do I know which policies I need to follow?

Effective May 1, 2023 you will follow most Centura Health policies and procedures. However, many legacy Steward Health Care policies must continue to be followed during a limited transition period because of various reasons. For example, **you must continue to follow ALL legacy Steward Health Care policies and procedures that are related to direct patient care.** 

**QUESTION:** How will I know what other legacy Steward Health Care policies, in addition to the direct patient care policies, I should continue to follow during the limited transition period?

**ANSWER:** You will have access to a SharePoint site where the applicable legacy policies will be listed, and the actual policies can be found there as well.
