<b>Basic essentials</b>	Laundry soap, dryer sheets, fabric softener, dryer balls, hand soaps (liquid), dish soap, towels and washcloths, hairspray, hair mousse, hair gel  <i>Please note that we are unable to accept over-the-counter medications.</i>
<b>Paper goods</b>	Toilet paper, paper towels, paper plates & cups, napkins
<b>Kitchen supplies</b>	Mugs, reusable/travel mugs
<b>Food items</b>	Coffee
<b>Toys, kid/teen-friendly and adult activities</b>	Kids small toys, teen stuff (electronics, books, games), crayons, teen stuff (electronics, books, games)
<b>Clothing</b>	Pajamas (all sizes), new clothing for all adult sizes, new clothing for teen boys, new clothing for 5-7-year-old boys and girls
<b>Winter clothing</b>	Gloves
<b>Pet essentials</b>	Dog and cat food, dog and cat supplies
<b>Electronics and device chargers</b>	Apple chargers, tablets, iPads
